Provision of consultancy services for updating the Mediterranean MoU procedures

Question 01 (dated 6/03/2014, time 12:10):

Will the documents referred to in Section 2.1 of the 'Tender Specifications' which are not available publically be made available to the contractor? For example, the relevant Paris MoU PSCC Instructions, MED MoU and Black Sea MoU Manuals and previous version of Paris MoU (mentioned in 1.7 of 'non-binding advices').

Answer to Question 01:

The documents referred to in Section 2.1 of the "Tender Specifications" have to be intended as guidance and upon request will be made available to contractor only for the execution of the contract.

Question 02 (dated 6/03/2014, time 12:10):

The scheme for the MED MoU procedures listed in Section 2.1 of Tender Specifications requires a list of relevant guidelines under 2. 'Guidelines on relevant instruments'. In the 'non-binding advices' a number of Paris MoU PSCC Instructions are mentioned. Is the Paris MoU content for its instructions to be listed and made available to the MED MoU or is the suggestion that the instructions are modified and reproduced as MED MoU PSCC Instructions?

Answer to Question 02:

The scheme is a guidance for the consultant and intends to provide him/her with an indication of the desired structure for the MEDMoU procedures as well as with an indication of the desired content for the MEDMOU instructions. MEDMoU instructions have to meet the needs of the MEDMoU Committee and will not be a duplication of the Paris MoU instructions. These lasts will not be made available for MEDMoU.
