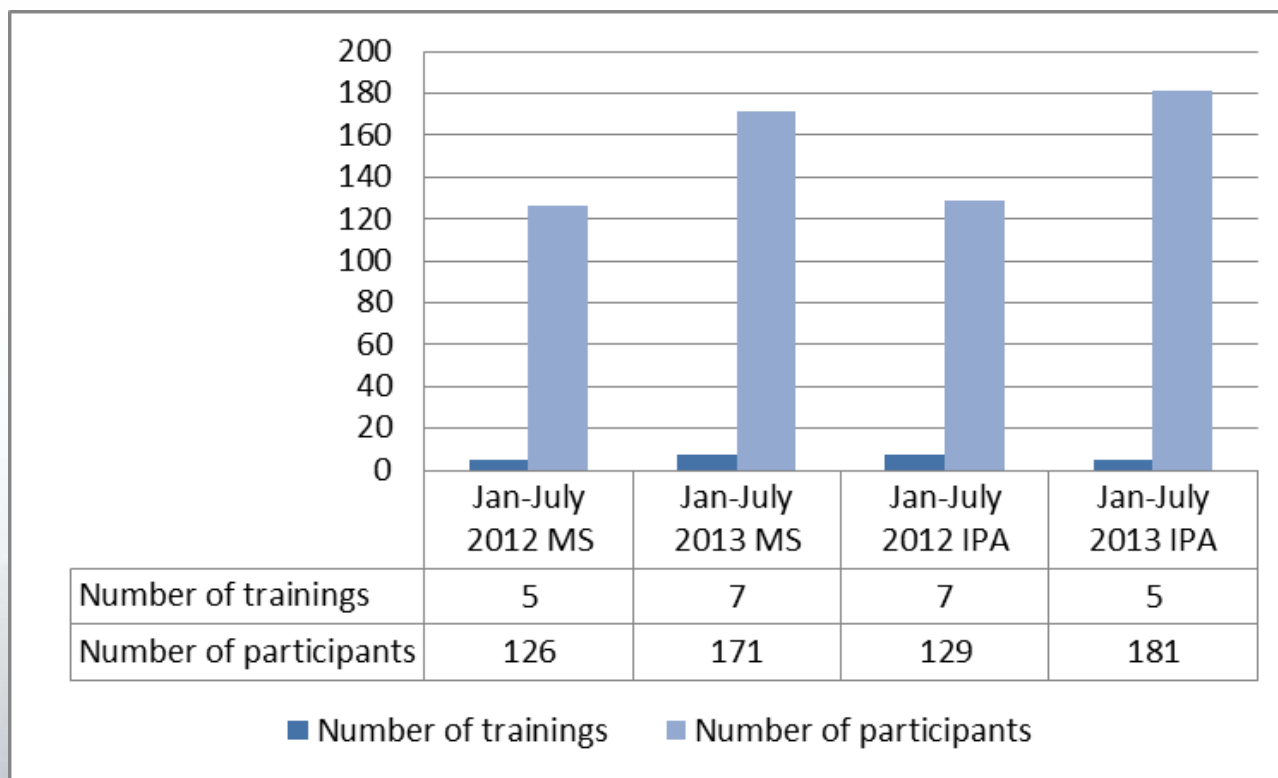

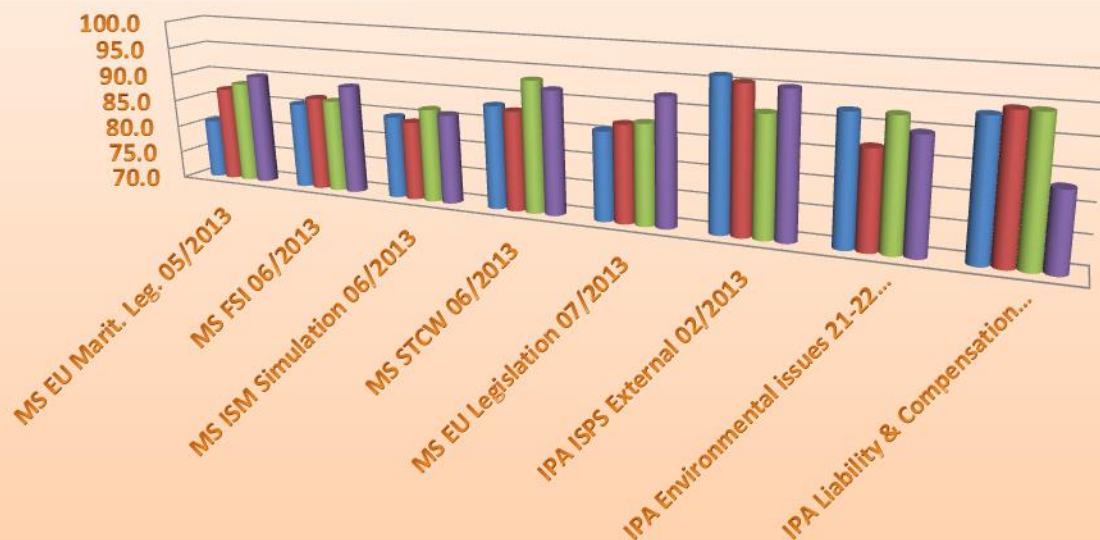

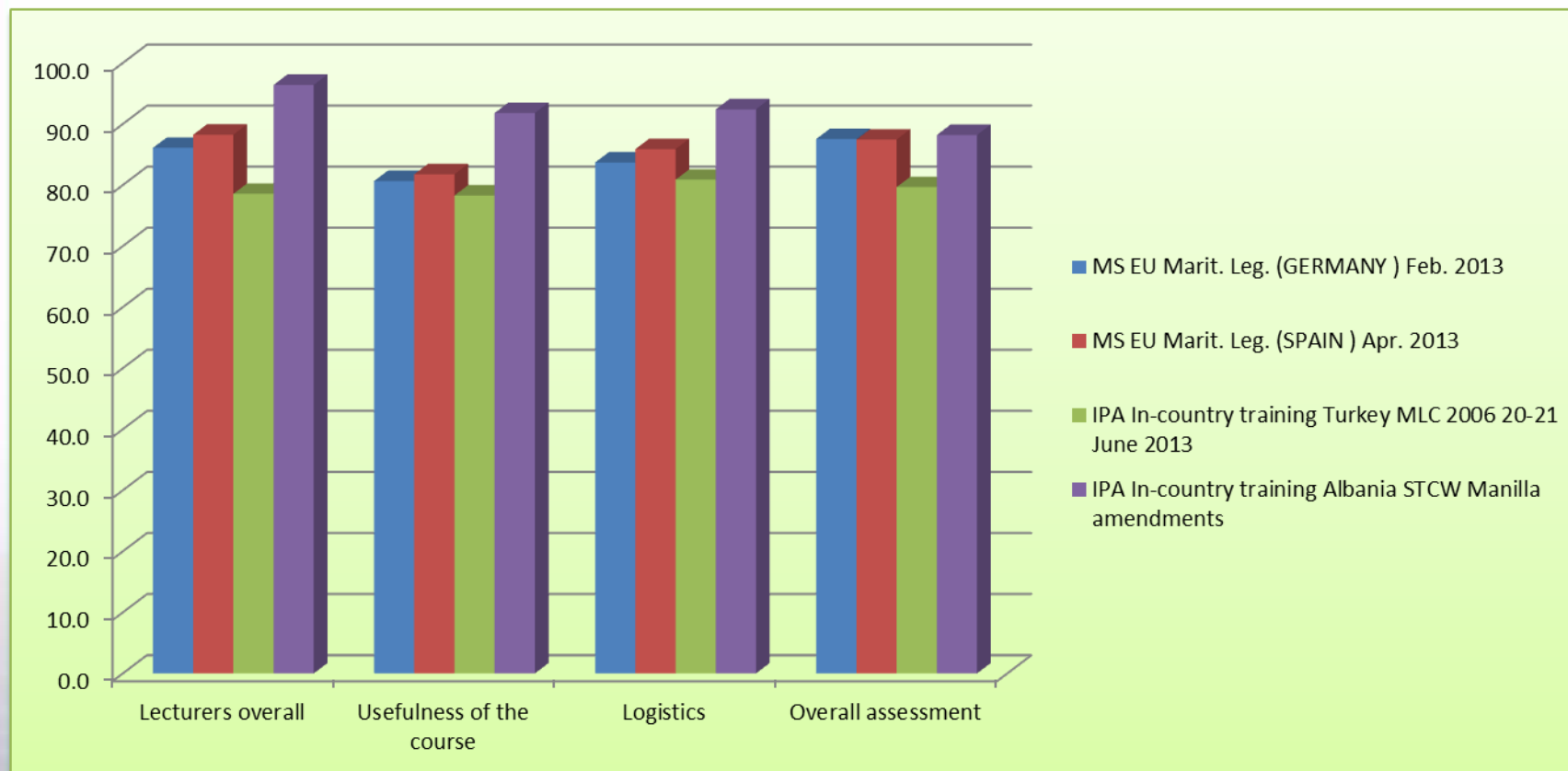

Some conclusions based on the assessment of the courses' evaluation

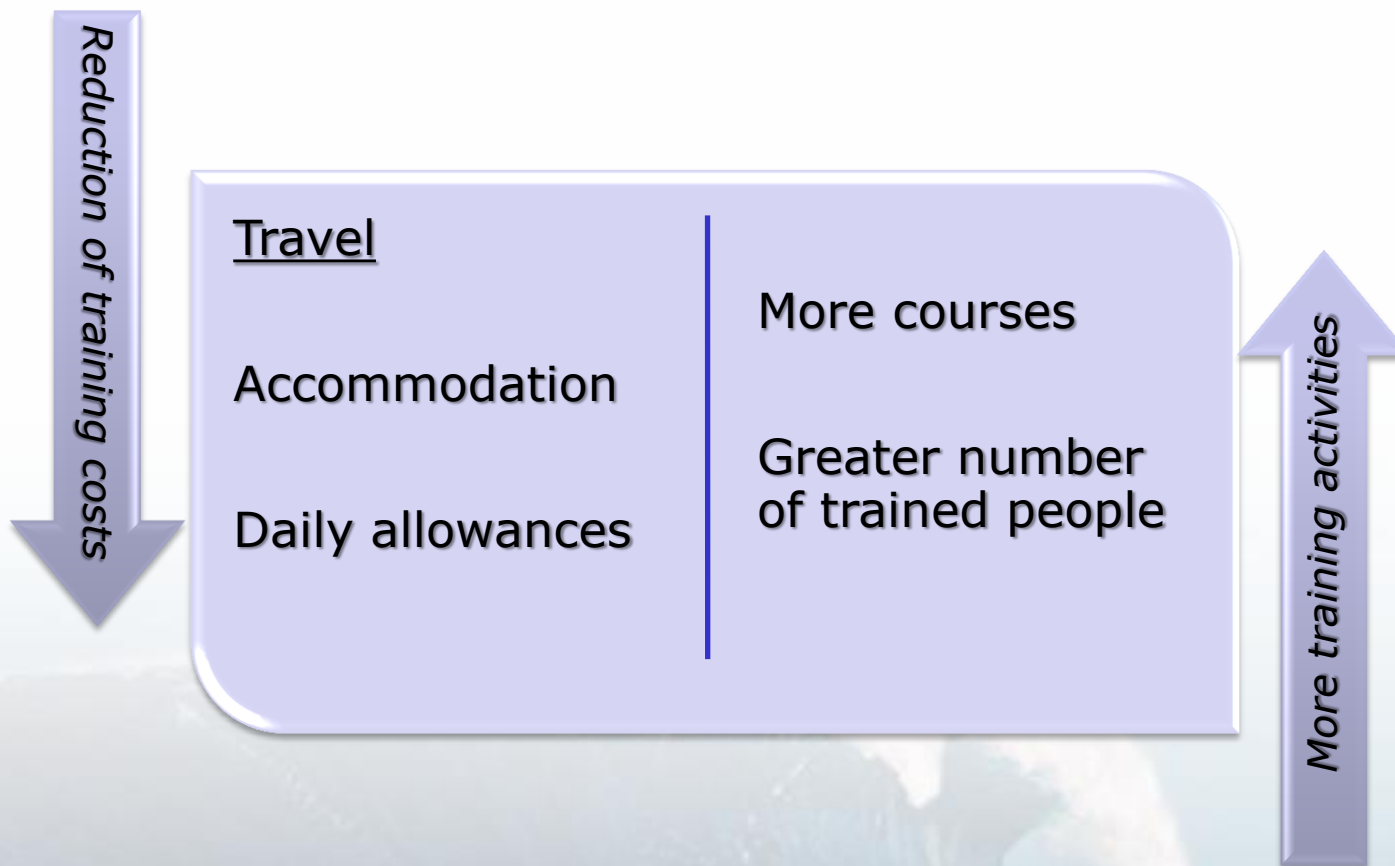


- Participants should be carefully selected based on the relevance of the training to their duties and job (bear in mind the potential beneficiaries and course objectives contained in the Inventory)

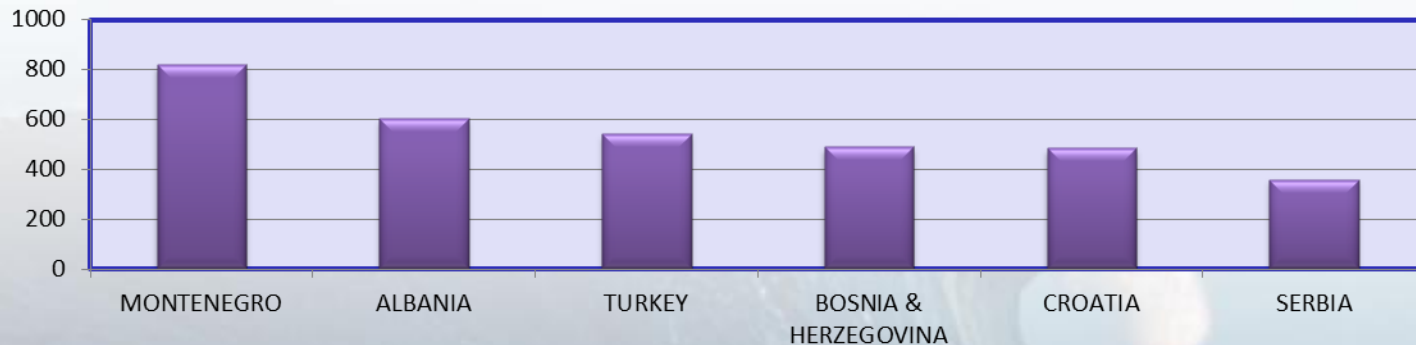
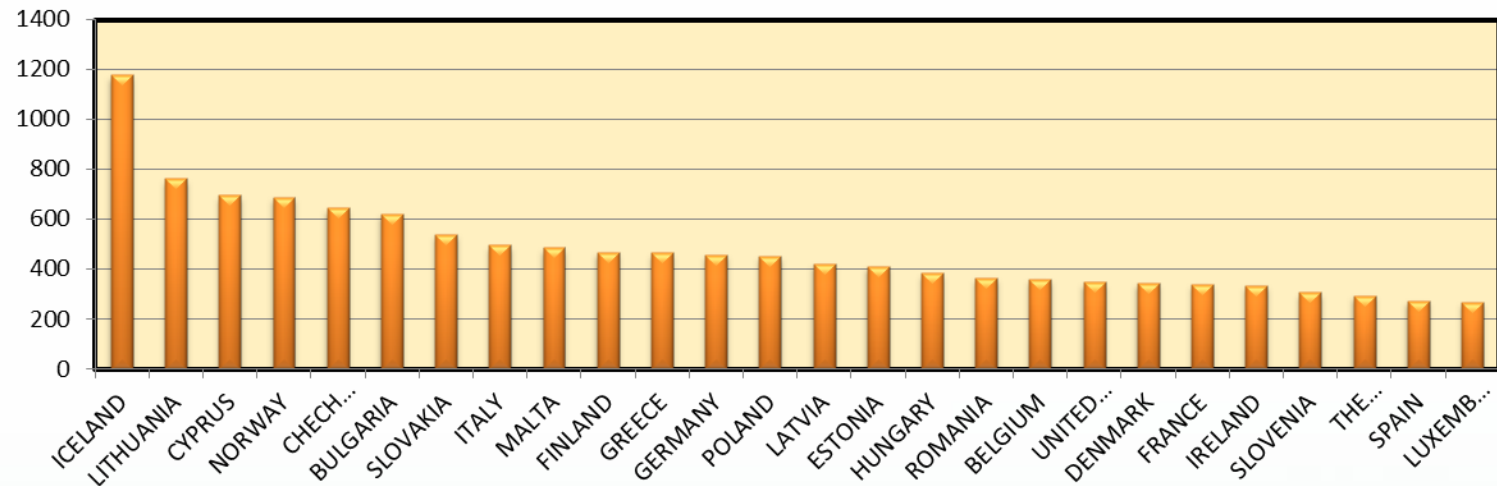
- The number of trainees in regional and in-country courses should not exceed 40 participants per course
- Trainees should have a good command in English language or interpretation should be provided

- The provision of information on the participants' particular interests related to the course topic and their expectations will enable EMSA team to better adapt the agenda to their needs

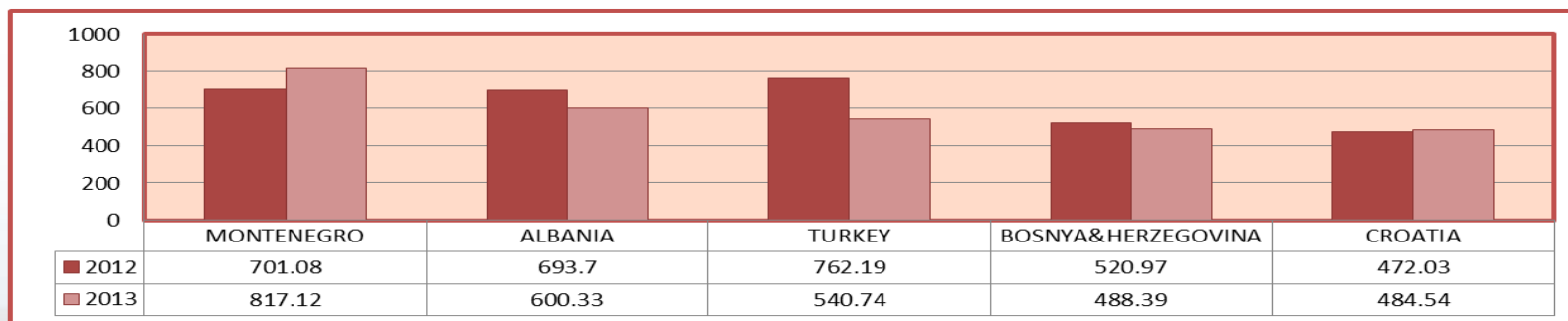
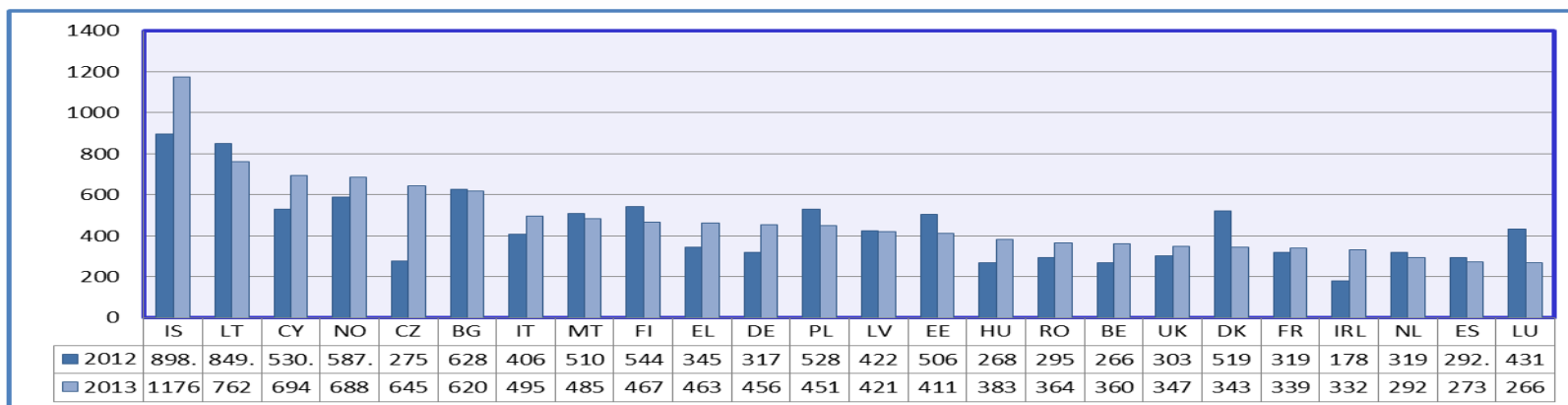
Training costs



Average amounts paid for transportation January – July 2013



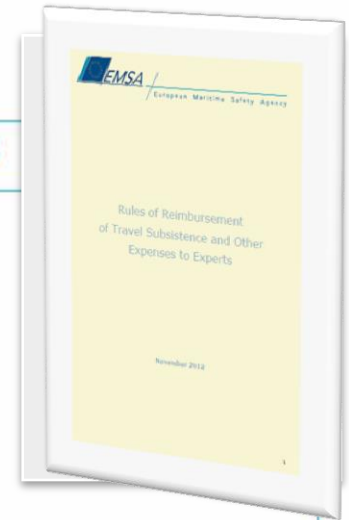
Average travel expenses per country 2012 vs 2013



9,45% increase (41,61€ more) of the average flight ticket cost for MS's



6,95% decrease (43,77€ less) of the average flight ticket cost for IPA countries



More financial matters

2012 revision of the Rules of reimbursement

- ❖ ***travel costs*** - when a ticket is booked via travel agency the handling fee will be reimbursed up to a maximum amount of €30, notwithstanding any additional credit card fees
- ❖ ***accommodation*** - experts shall receive reimbursement of their accommodation expenses actually incurred up to a maximum of €120 per necessary overnight stay
- ❖ ***for half days training*** the 2/3 of the full daily allowance is given to the participants thus 53 €
- ❖ ***supporting documents*** - costs to be evidenced by appropriate original documents

Regional training for MS's and in-country training for IPA countries

- ❖ ***EMSA*** covers the full expenses of the lecturers only
