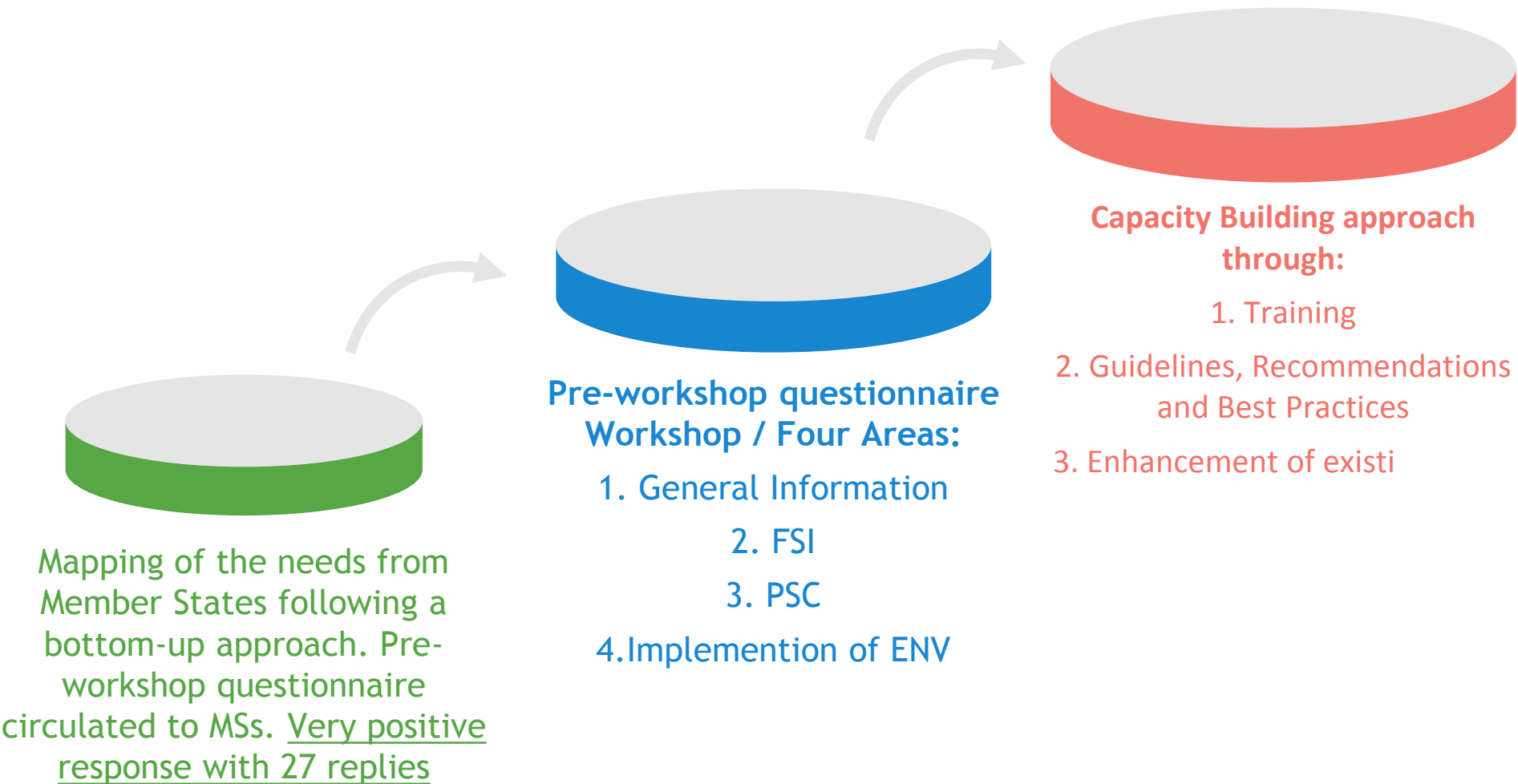

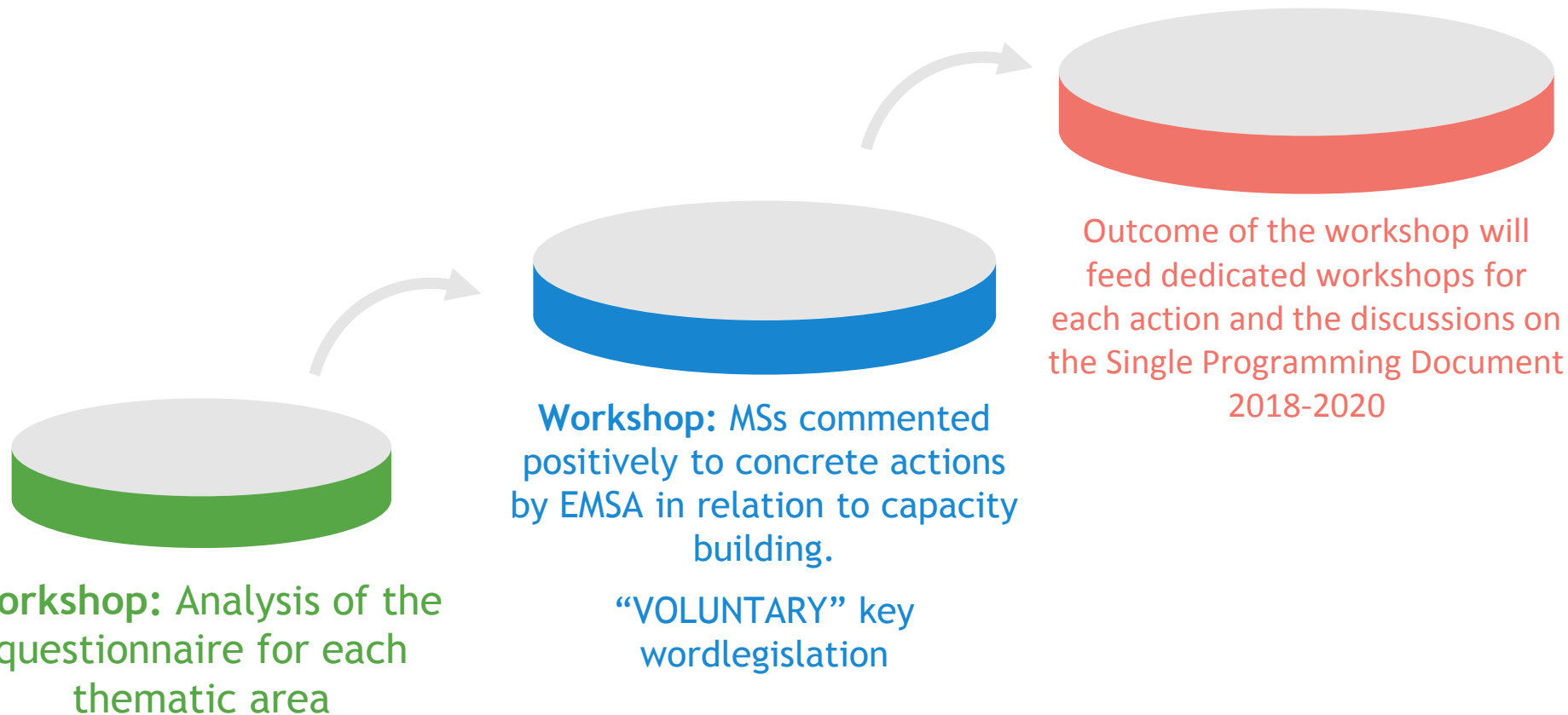

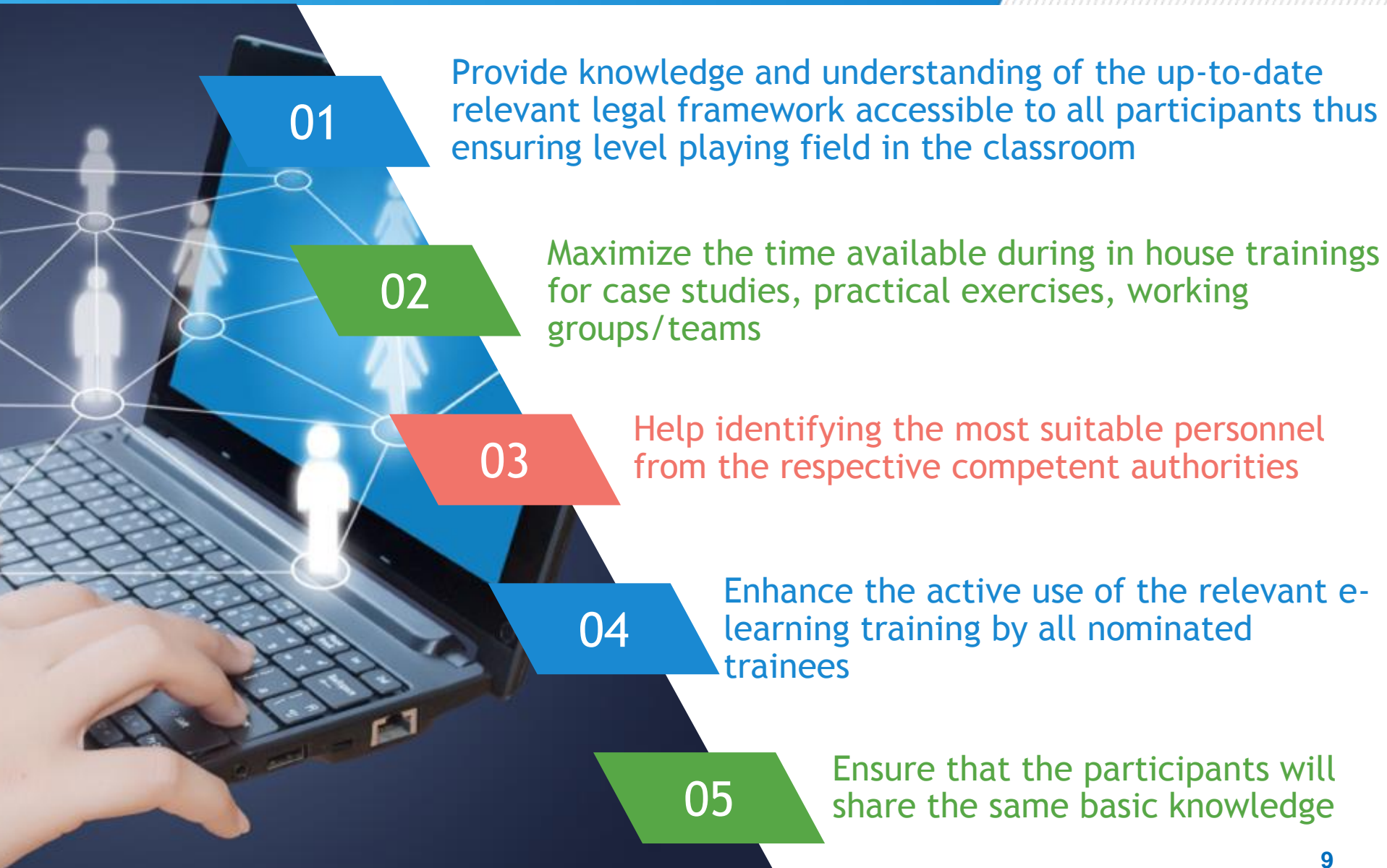
Participants will be required / recommended to undergo the relevant eLearning module before attending the specialised course in EMSA premises. CNTA focal points to decide

Participants failing to undergo the eLearning module will not be allowed to take part to the specialised in house training CNTA focal points to decide

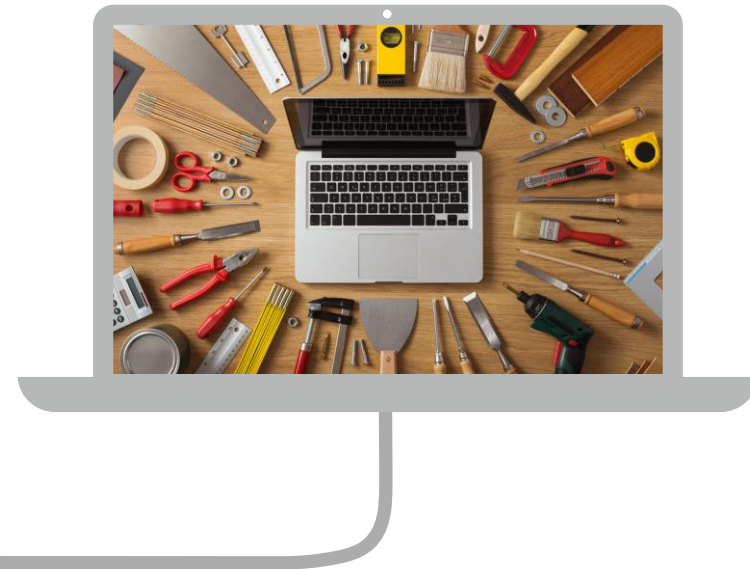
