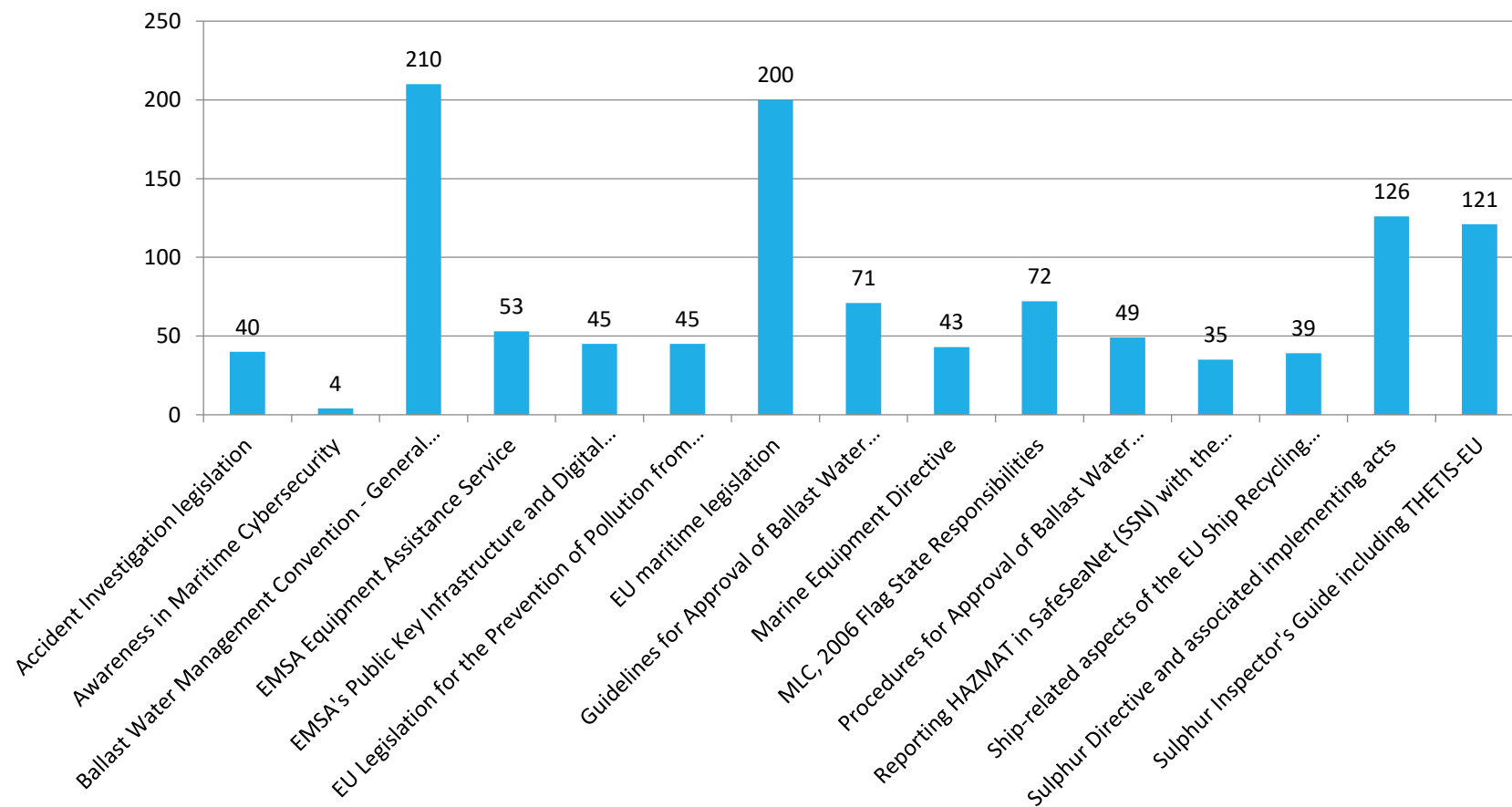

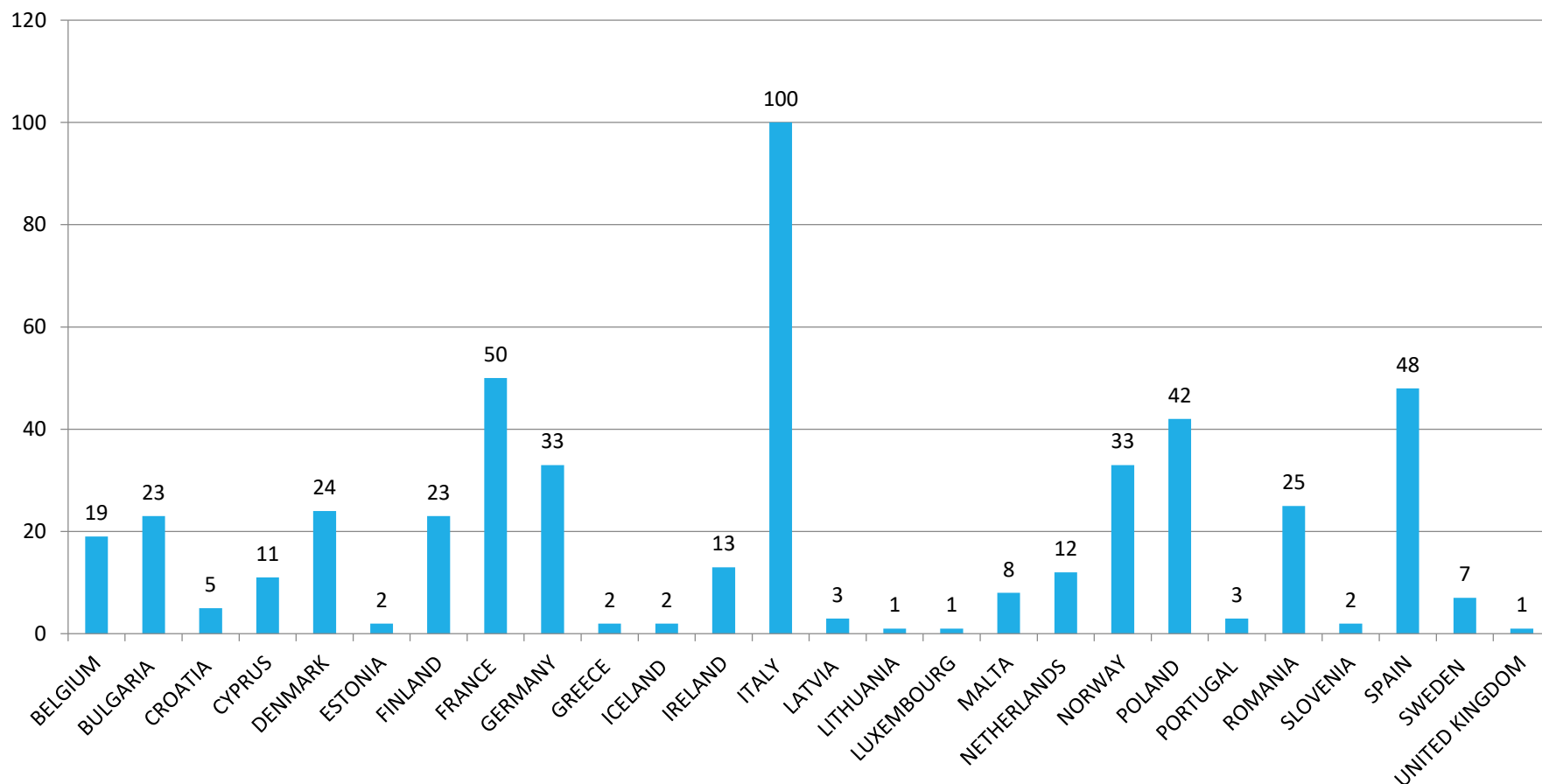


Number of users who have accessed the course





Number of individual users under Capacity Building (Total 493)

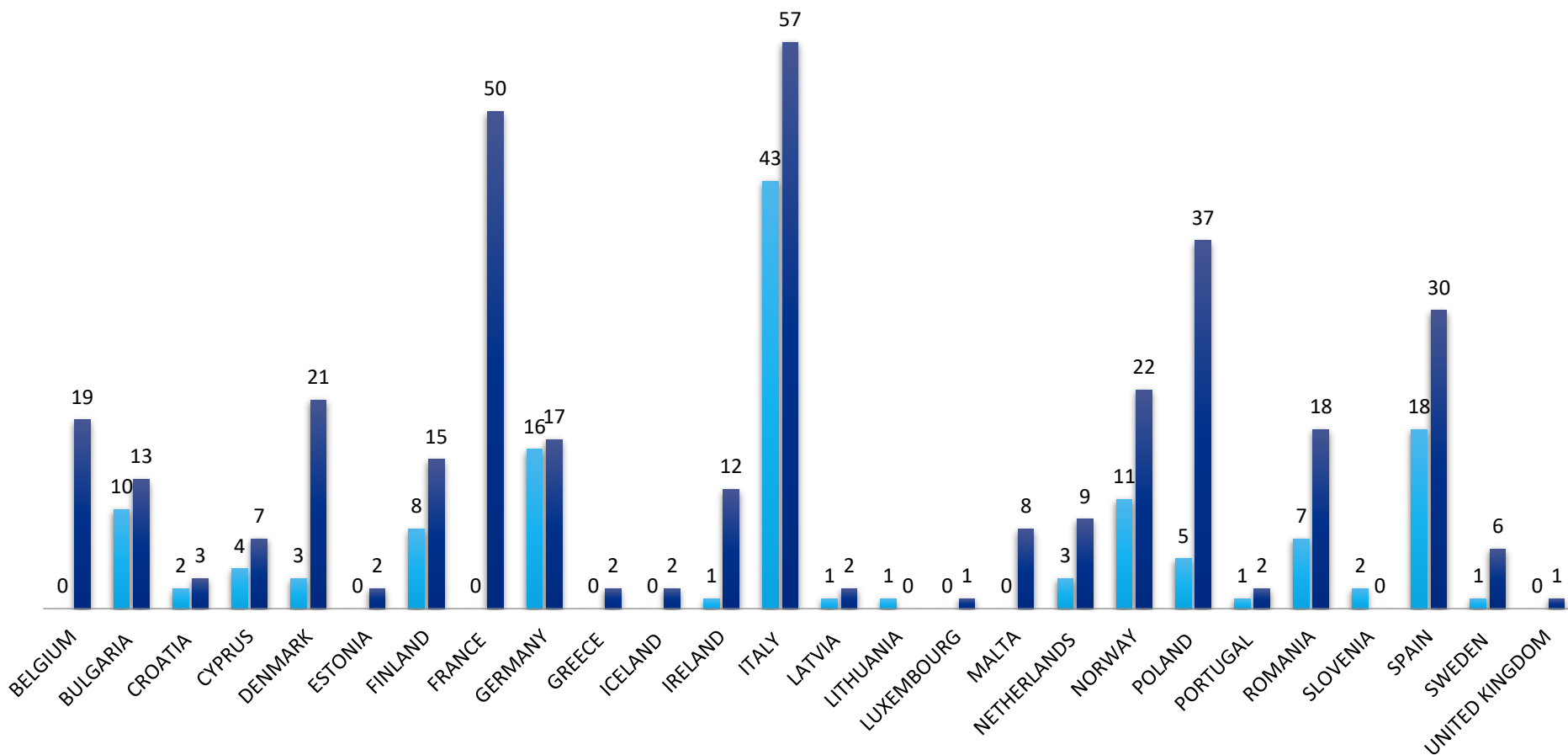

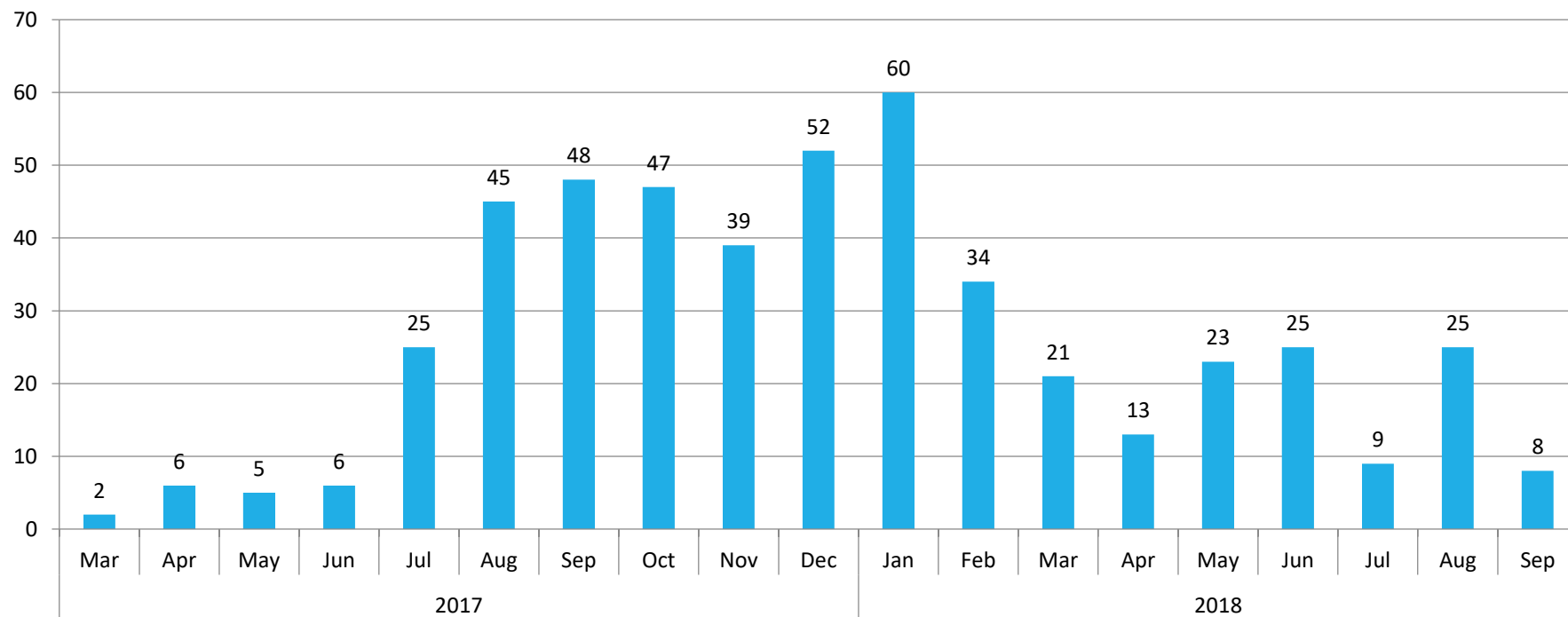
■ Number of new users 01/10/2016 -30/09/2017

■ Number of new Users 01/10/2017 - 01/10/2018

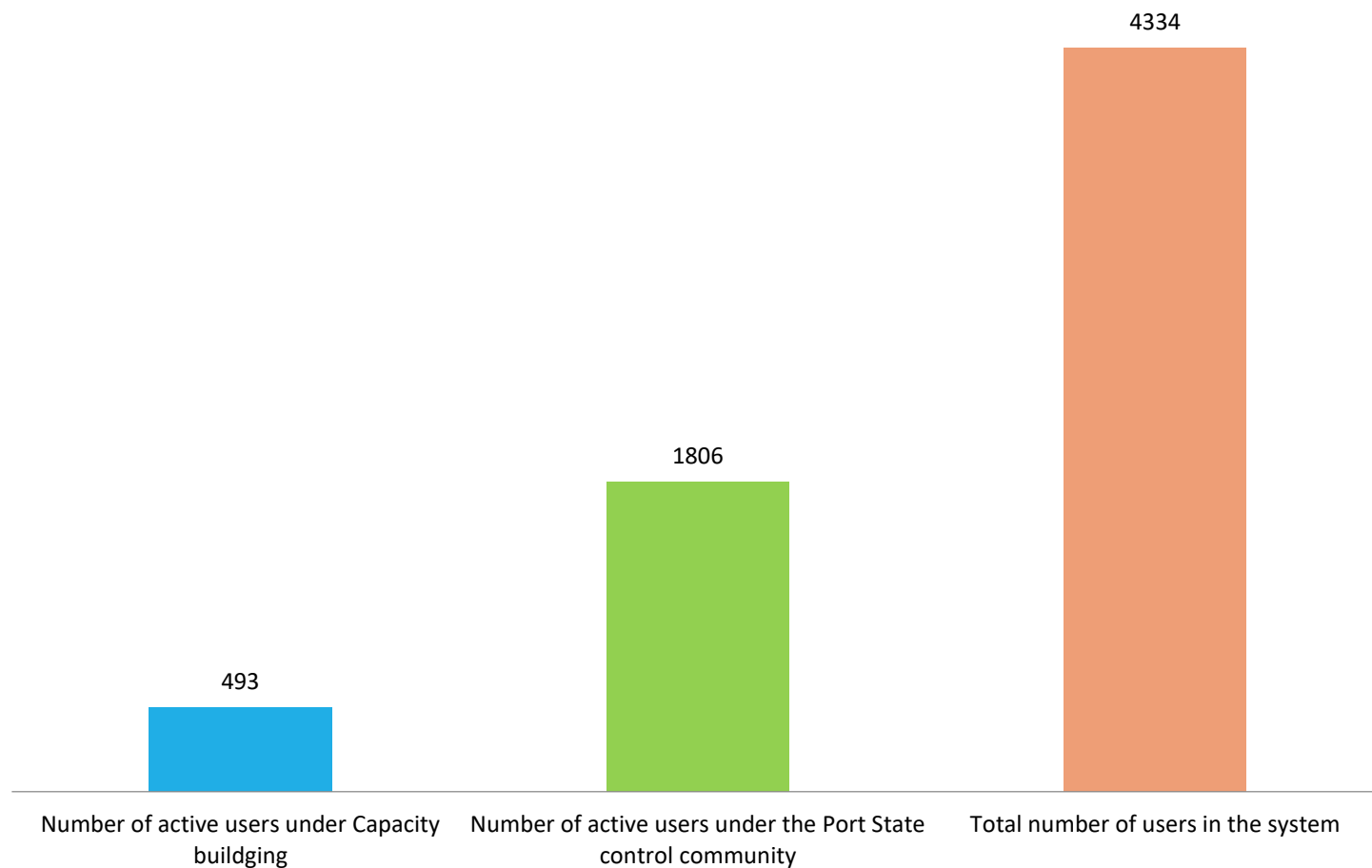




Number of new users accessing the system
