provides continuous update of knowledge as required by the III Code

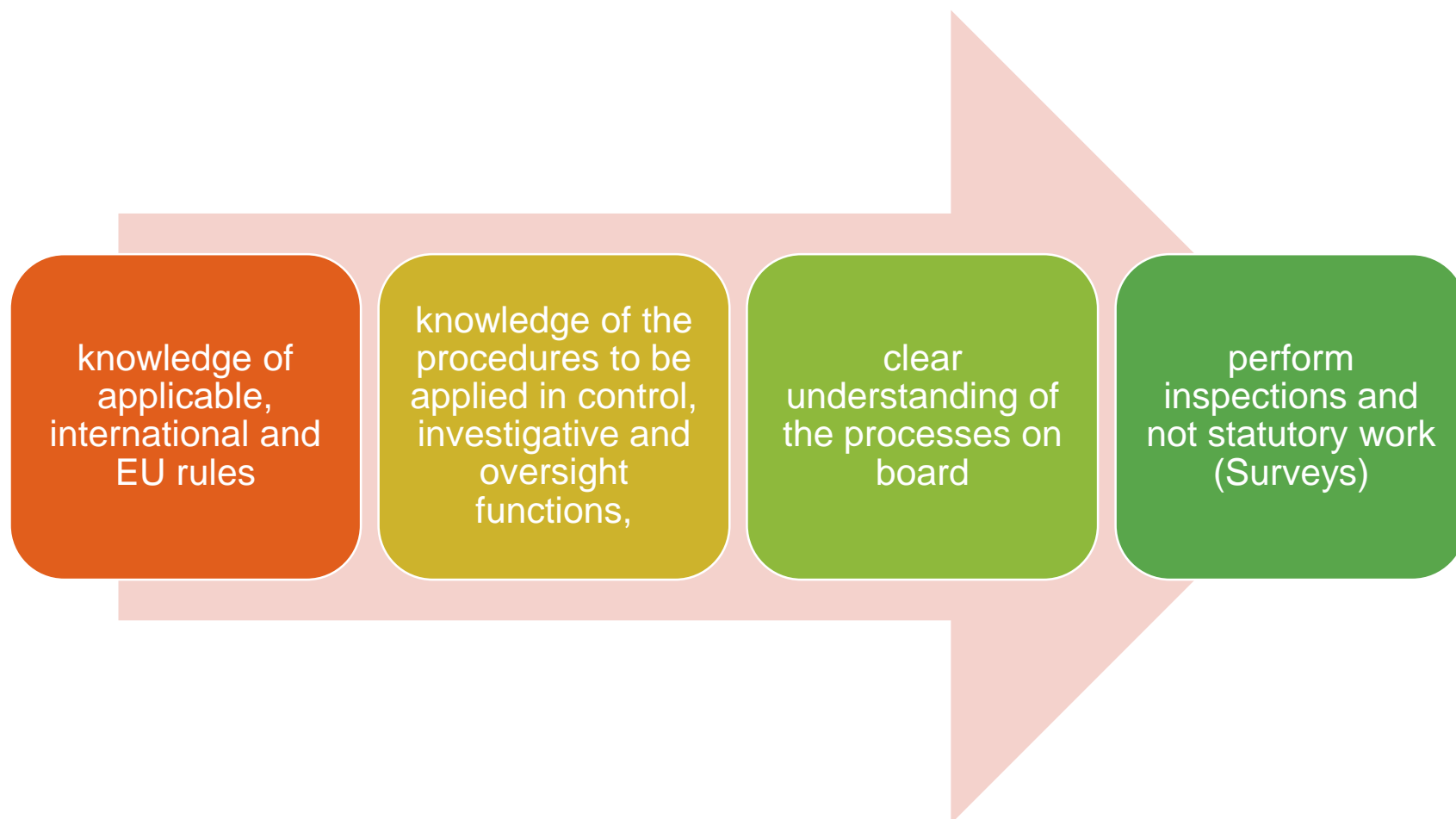

address all the areas of a ship and does not follow a “conventional check list” approach

makes reference to all applicable IMO & ILO conventions (per ship type) as well as the relevant EU additional requirements in the field of the Environmental legislation

IMSAS with particular focus on periodic and supplementary FS inspections as well as investigations by the FS after detentions

How to verify that the actual condition of the ship and its crew is in conformity with the certificates it carries and other applicable EU law
