

Record of changes in EMSWe MIG v2.0.1 compared with v1.0.0

This document presents the changes that were made to the formalities and responses in the European Maritime Single Window's Message Implementation Guide (EMSWe MIG) v2.0.1 compared with v1.0.0.

ABS

- DE-035-02 (Person family name) has been made mandatory as follow-up to open issue 130.
- As follow up to DMR 354, DE-003-05 (Attachment file name) has been added and mapped with attribute [Attached File].[Name].
- As follow up to DMR 355, DE-003-06 (Attachment MIME type) has been added and mapped with attribute [Attached File].[MIME Code].

ACT

- A new data element DE-051-24 (Tank prewash exemption indicator), used by IT, has been added in class [Associated transport equipment] as per DMR 338 approved at DMWG7.
- As follow up to DMR 337, DE-051-23 (Tank washing water quantity) has been added and mapped with attribute [Associated Transport Equipment].[Wash Water Quantity]. Rule R-GENERAL-004 has been applied.
- Rule R-GENERAL-039 has been applied to DE-076-04 (Expected activity end time), to ensure that end time is after start time.

- Mapping of DE-015-06 (Actual first location) has been changed from [Occurrence Location].[ID] to [Occurrence Location].[Subordinate Location].[Name], because a location in a port corresponds to a subordinate location in MMT.

- Mapping of DE-016-06 (Actual last port call location) has been changed from [Occurrence Location].[ID] to [Occurrence Location].[Subordinate Location].[Name], because a location in a port corresponds to a subordinate location in MMT.

BKD

- As follow up to DMR 354, DE-003-05 (Attachment file name) has been added and mapped with attribute [Attached File].[Name].
- As follow up to DMR 355, DE-003-06 (Attachment MIME type) has been added and mapped with attribute [Attached File].[MIME Code].

- Format of data element DE-072-08 (Bunker delivery date) has been change from an..32 to an..35 to make it consistent with all other data elements.

BLR

- Condition C-GENERAL-006, which had been applied to RE-006-02 (Operations expected end date time) by mistake, has been removed.
- Rule R-GENERAL-039 has been added to RE-006-02 (Operations expected end date time) to control that the end date-time is after the start date-time.

BLU

- As follow up to DMR 354, DE-003-05 (Attachment file name) has been added and mapped with attribute [Attached File].[Name].
- As follow up to DMR 355, DE-003-06 (Attachment MIME type) has been added and mapped with attribute [Attached File].[MIME Code].
- Rule R-GENERAL-039 has been applied to DE-076-04 (Expected activity end time), to ensure that end time is after start time.
- Format of data element DE-066-01 (Expected duration of ballast operations) has been changed from an..35 to n..5 because an integer must be reported according to rule R-GENERAL-044.

CAR

- Cases of duplicated condition C-GENERAL-007 have been corrected.
- DE-064-58 (Requested validity of the proof justification) has been added because existing in IEP61, and condition C-CGM-001 has been applied to it. It replaces DE-003-01 (Remarks) which was incorrectly used for reporting that information.
- DE-003-01 (Remarks) has been removed because not used in IEP61.
- Condition C-CGM-013 has been removed from DE-048-10 (Cargo item package type, coded) because not relevant for that data element.
- Condition C-CGM-013 has been split in two to have C-CGM-013 applied to DE-048-09 (Cargo item number of packages) and DE-048-10 (Cargo item package type, coded), and a new condition C-CGM-015 applied to DE-048-08 (Cargo item marks and numbers). The purpose is to have a similar presentation as in AES formalities (C-EXS-008 and C-EXS-007).
- Rule R-GENERAL-034 applied to DE-048-01 (Cargo item number) has been replaced by R-GENERAL-021 (because DE-048-01 corresponds to an attribute [Sequence Number]).

- MS mapping has been added to DE-045-01 (Manifest type, coded) because this is a part-C element and to make it similar to CGA.
- Mapping with Germany has been added to DE-045-08 (Number of empty containers TEU on board) because this is a part-C element and to make it similar to CGA.
- MS mapping with BG, FR, IT has been added to DE-045-17 (Type of cargo, coded).
- Mapping with France has been added to DE-065-01 (Driver first name) and DE-065-02 (Driver last name) because this is a part-C element and to make it similar to CGA.

- Condition C-CRT-004 has been added to reflect business rule BR-058 and has been applied to data element DE-006-09 (Certificate issuer name).

- Guideline G-CUS-001 has been applied to class [Exchanged Document].[Attached File].

CWA, CWD

- Guideline G-PXA-001 has been rephrased for clarity.
- Condition C-GENERAL-003 has been removed from DE-035-06 (Person place of birth name) because not applicable.
- DE-035-02 (Person family name) has been made mandatory as follow-up to open issue 130.

DUE

- As follow up to DMR 367, DE-077-22 (Due method of payment, coded) has been added and mapped with attribute [Call Event].[Fairway and Port Dues].[Applicable Payment].[Method Code].

- As follow up to DMR 368, the name of attribute [Receipt ID], corresponding to DE-077-10 (Due payment identification number) has been changed to [Proof ID] and its format has been changed to “an..100”.
- The data element DE-002-12 (Previous formality LRN) has been added on the request of IT.

- As follow up to DMR 350, DE-036-02 (Crew effects description, coded) has been added and mapped with attribute [Crew Travel Effects].[Type Code].
- Consequently, to the above, DE-036-02 (Crew effects description, coded) has been set to mandatory while DE-036-01 (Crew effects description) has been set to optional. New condition C-EFF-001 has been added to DE-036-01.

EXS

- Guideline G-EXS-008 (which corresponds to TAXUD DDNXA guideline G0107) has been added to DE-048-03 (Cargo item gross mass).
- In conditions C-EXS-007 and C-EXS-008, references to TAXUD code lists CL181 (bulk) and CL182 (unpacked) have been replaced by explicit code values (as in PoUS conditions C-CGM-013 and C-CGM-015).
- In rule R-EXS-005, reference to code list CL182 (unpacked) has been replaced by explicit code values.
- Condition C-EXS-023 have been reworded for clarity.
- Guideline G-GENERAL-009 has been replaced by new rule R-GENERAL-046.
- Conditions C-EXS-018 and C-EXS-024 have been changed into guidelines G-EXS-019 and G-EXS-020 respectively.
- Rule R-GENERAL-034 applied to DE-048-01 (Cargo item number) has been replaced by R-GENERAL-021 (because DE-048-01 corresponds to an attribute [Sequence Number]).

- New data elements DE-052-10 (Ventilation method description), DE-052-08 (Ventilation after fumigation start date time) and DE-052-09 (Ventilation after fumigation end date time), used by IT, have been added in a new class [Logistics Transport Equipment].[Related Ventilation Event] as per DMRs 340 and 342 approved at DMWG7.
- Rule R-GENERAL-039 has been added to DE-052-09 (Ventilation after fumigation end date time) to control that the end date-time is after the start date-time.

- Cardinalities of DE-047-01 (Port of loading, coded), DE-047-04 (Port of discharge, coded) and DE-046-13 (Explosives or fireworks indicator) have been changed to 1..1 because they are alone in their classes.

This change has been made to avoid using the same MMT attribute [Size/Type Code] for both data elements DE-051-17 (Container size and type, coded), which uses ISO 6346 size and type codes, and DE-051-13 (Transport equipment size and type, coded) which uses UN/EDIFACT code list 8155.

- Codes "MFX" and "TSR" have been added to code list Formality type.
- Guidelines G-MAI-003 and G-MAI-004 have been removed as a follow-up to open issue 137.
- Guideline G-MAI-007 has been rephrased to make it more general and not only limited to EXS ("Report [MRN] when this is required for updating a Customs formality"), leaving it to the Member States to determine for which customs formalities it is required.
- A new rule R-MAI-004 has been applied to DE-002-08 (Message function, coded) to reflect principle MIG-P29.
- C-MAI-001 has been aligned with MIG-P14 (condition applied to formalities ACT, CGA, CGD, MFX and TSR and DUE as well).
- Cases of duplicated condition C-GENERAL-007 have been corrected.
- In guideline G-MAI-007, reference to MRN has been corrected by using the actual MMT attribute's name.
