### **Compliance steps in 2025** The shipping company perspective in respect of 2024 emissions

31 December 2024: ETS Maritime first monitoring year ends

As soon as possible and <u>no later than 31 March 2025</u>: submission of verified end of year ship-level emissions reports (ER) and company-level emissions reports (CER) through THETIS-MRV

By 31 March 2025: have emissions in the Union Registry MOHA marked as verified

By <u>**30 September 2025**</u>: surrender the due EU allowances in the Union Registry

If the shipping company does not meet the legal deadlines it will be non-compliant with the legislative requirements under MRV/ETS
