Development of secondary legislation

- Implementing act on the FuelEU database to be published in October 2025
- Implementing act on neighbouring transhipment ports revised version to be published in December 2025
- Draft IA on OPS communication to be published in Q1 2026



Guidance documents

Under development; be published in Q4 2025

General guidance document

- Support implementation of the FuelEU Maritime Regulation
- Explain requirements in non-legislative language
- Provide additional information

Target audience: Shipping companies

Guidance document Certification of Actual non-CO2 TtW EF



IMO Net-Zero Framework and impacts on FuelEU Maritime

IMO NZF - integrated measure:

- 1. Global fuel standard for gradually reducing the GHG intensity of marine fuels
- 2. Pricing part of the GHG emissions from international shipping

Vote on adoption in mid-October!

FuelEU and (ETS Maritime) include clear **obligations for producing a report on the interaction between IMO and EU measures** and **potential legislative proposal for alignment**:

"..need to avoid duplicating regulation of GHG emissions from maritime transport at Union as well as international level.."

"...preserving the environmental integrity and effectiveness of the Union climate action..."
