DECISION OF THE EUROPEAN MARITIME SAFETY AGENCY

on the adoption of Implementing Rules to the Staff Regulations

The Administrative Board of the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA),

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities, laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, EUROATOM, ECSC) No 259/68 and last amended by Council Regulation (CE, EUROATOM) No 723/2004 of 22 March 2004, and in particular to Article 110 of the Staff Regulations;

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EC) n° 1406/2002 of 27 June 2002 establishing the European Maritime Safety Agency and in particular article 6 thereof;

Having regard to the decisions of the Commission setting up implementing rules for the application of amended Staff Regulations of officials of the European Communities and the Conditions of Employment of other servants of the Employment Communities;

Whereas,

- (1) implementing rules for the Agency should be adopted pursuant Article 110 of Staff Regulations
- (2) the Commission has given approval to the present decision subject to the relevant Staff Committee referred to in that provision being informed of it when that Committee has been set up and subject to taking account, where appropriate, of any opinion given
- (3) the Staff Committee has been consulted and has given its opinion

Has adopted the following general implementing rules:


Article 1

The general implementing rules of the Staff Regulations, as adopted by the Commission, and listed in Annex I, shall apply by analogy to the staff of the European Maritime Safety Agency.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force with effect from the date of its adoption by the Administrative Board of EMSA.
