

DECISION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF 05 SEPTEMBER 2014

Adopting Implementing Rules regarding the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union (SR) and Conditions of Employment of other Servants of the European Union (CEOS)

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN MARITIME SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) N° 1406/2002 of 27 June 2002, as amended, establishing the European Maritime Safety Agency, and in particular Article 6 thereof;

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials (Staff Regulations) and Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union (CEOS), laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, EURATOM, ECSC) N° 259/68, as last amended¹, and in particular to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations and Articles 2(f), 8, 14, 53, 55 and 56 of the CEOS;

Having regard to the decisions of the Commission setting up implementing rules for the application of the revised Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union and the Conditions of Employment of other servants of the European Union which shall apply by analogy to the agencies and enter into force nine months after their entry into force at the Commission, pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations;

Whereas an Agency may decide that such implementing rules enter into force at an earlier date after consultation of the Staff Committee, pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations;

After consultation of the Staff Committee,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The general implementing rule of the Staff Regulations, as adopted by the Commission and mentioned in Annex, shall apply by analogy to the staff of EMSA.

Article 2

This decision shall take effect on the day following that of its adoption.
