

André Hansen
Biographical notice

In May 2022, André Hansen was appointed Commissioner for Maritime Affairs. The agency he is heading is the focal point of all shipping matters in Luxembourg.

He currently also serves as a board member of the European Maritime Safety (EMSA) since November 2022.

Having joined the Ministry of the Economy in 2000, Mr. Hansen has held several positions in that Ministry over the years:

- from 2013 to 2022, Mr. Hansen was serving as Deputy Director General of the Directorate for Trade and Investment Promotion. In this capacity, he was responsible for the organization of numerous economic missions all over the world and for managing Luxembourg's international network of trade and investment offices.
- in addition to that, Mr. Hansen was a member of the "Trade and Investment Steering Committee" as well as Chairman of the government's one-stop-shop for exporters at the Luxembourg Export Credit Agency until 2022.
- having been a board member of the organizational body of Luxembourg's presence at World Expo 2020 in Dubai, Mr. Hansen was appointed, in October 2021, Commissioner General of the Luxembourg participation at World Expo 2025 in Osaka, Japan.
- from 2010 to 2015, he was appointed Deputy Director for International Trade Fairs and Exhibitions in charge of organizing national pavilions at trade fairs for various key economic sectors.

Mr. Hansen was born in 1980, is married and father of two children. He speaks Luxembourgish, English, French and German.
